Updates & Discussion

FOCUS FORWARD CONFERENCE

The Diocese is in the process of cutting us a check for **\$6,023**. This added to the **\$4,240** from Focus Forward puts us over **\$10,000**! We are looking forward to the 2023 event which is scheduled for October 21st.

<u>BGCF GOODGIVING CHALLENGE</u> - We received a check for \$435.78. As a part of this we received \$131.63 from the Marksbury Match. I wasn't expecting this! We had another donation on Giving Tuesday for \$500, but it was sent directly to us. I am meeting with Lauren Parsons at BGCF to plan for the 2023 GG Challenge. I think with a good plan we can increase our donations during the next challenge this fall.
