3. Treasurer/Finance Report was presented by Dan Bork and approved by the Board. Luminaria profit: around 190K. It would be good to reach out more throughout the whole diocese. Dan is in process of updating our insurance, including investigation into insuring our event(s). Kim filled out a gaming report. CEOF can now invite the diocesan parishes and schools that have an endowment fund for tuition assistance to come under the CEOF umbrella, on condition that each of the Letter of Agreement of the interested parties be reviewed by the Diocesan Finance Council.
